## **IMAGE2000 - PROCEDURE FOR DELIVERY OF ORTHO-RECTIFIED IMAGES**

*Draft working document version 1.0*

### **Introduction**

After the validation and acceptance by the JRC of the test image for a country, the operational production of ortho-rectified images can start. The reason to wait for the validation is to avoid repeating error on the correction if it is related to the transformation parameters used.

### **Delivery of ortho-rectified images**

The ortho-rectified images once ready are sent by SSC to the National Administration/team appointed and at the same time to the JRC. This is to avoid delays and to permit the national team to start the interpretation.

SSC will notify officially the JRC and The National Administrations by a "Image Deliverable Notification" form (e-mail) sent the date of expedition

### **Ortho-rectification progress**

In order to facilitate the follow up, the visibility and the management of the CLC2000 by the National teams, SSC is requested to update weekly the Web catalogue with the following information for each validated frames:

- **Status:** Raw image ordered, delivered, ortho-rectification in progress, Internal quality check, Ortho image available, delivered to National Administration.
- **Date of delivery** (expected /final).
- **Any other relevant comment.**

## **Validation of ortho-rectified images**

The JRC will validate Ten percent of the European frames. Each country must have at least one ortho-rectified image validated. (method for validation documented).

However, if the National Administration find problems with an ortho-rectified image that was not a validated sample, the JRC and SSC should be informed with the documented problem. Depending upon the situation, the image should be validated as defined by JRC or re-corrected directly by SSC.

The methodology for validation will be distributed to the National Administration in case there is their intention to provide themselves for a validation of the all images. This should be done in coordination with the JRC but it can never replace the validation done by JRC.
